FACE MASK COVERINGS MANDATED BY WASHINGTON STATE

All staff will always wear a face mask during business hours at the office. The only exception would be those staff that have a medical condition that exempts them from wearing a mask, which will require a written notice from their primary care physician.

The credit union has now required only two '2' members in our credit union lobby at any one time to transact business.

Providing hand sanitizer and the ability to wash hands frequently for employees and members after handling cash/completing transactions.

Sanitizing common areas include work surfaces, door handles, light switches.
